For an additional Gift of \$250, a silver pin will be presented in addition to an inscribed plaque and \$500, with a gold pin. For an additional \$1,000 donation, fellows receive a lapel pin adorned with a diamond to the level of the Progressive Clement F. Kusiak program.
